IELTS is an international standardised test of English language proficiency and is one of the two major English-language tests in the world, the other being the TOEFL. Like the TOEFL, the scores are valid for two years.

IELTS is accepted by most Australian, British, Canadian, Irish, New Zealand and South African academic institutions, over 3,000 academic institutions in the United States, and various professional organisations across the world. It is also a requirement for immigration to Australia and New Zealand.

In 2012, 2 million candidates took the IELTS test in over 130 countries, making it the world's most popular English language test for higher education and immigration.
