Test of English as a Foreign Language or TOEFL is a standardised test of English language proficiency for non-native English language speakers wishing to enrol in U.S. universities, but it is now also accepted in most educational institutions worldwide. TOEFL is one of the two major English-language tests in the world, the other being the IELTS. Like the IELTS, the scores are valid for two years.

In Uruguay, all tests are now the internet-based TOEFL iBT.

The scores can be compared to IELTS and Cambridge exams:
